Importance of ICCP

ICCP is an Endeavour towards preparation of a group of health care professionals with expertise which is essential for effective implementation of infection control practices across all health care settings. By the infection control certification programme, we aim at developing specialized nurses in this field, equipped with adequate knowledge and skill needed for the maintenance of a safe hospital environment and health care delivery practices.

Credentials

Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences has conducted this certification program since 2011 and has certified 250 Registered Nurses from various parts of India over 15 Batches.

Training Overview

Infection control certification programme is a distance education programme delivered over a period of 8 weeks with 6 days mandatory contact sessions. There shall be an examination at the end of the course and the final evaluation is based on the completed log book, written exam and viva voce. Contact classes are arranged in two sessions of 3 days each.

Training package:

This includes printed course materials, log book and lectures by experienced resource personnel and field visit during contact programmes.

Eligibility for admission

1. Candidate should have B.Sc Nursing Degree / General Nursing and Midwifery / Post Basic B.Sc nursing
2. Should be registered in any of the nursing council in India.
3. Should be currently working in any of the Institutions [in or outside Kerala]
